### Where is the box office? Its hours?

Tickets can be purchased at the Clark Bookstore in Gaiser Hall during regular store hours Monday – Thursday 7:30 am to 6:30 pm, and Fridays till 5:00 pm. On the nights of the performance, the evening box office located at Decker theater in the Frost Arts center opens at 6:30 pm. You may purchase tickets if any remain or pick up your will call tickets there.

### If I don't order a subscription by mail now, may I still obtain season tickets?

Yes, but seating choices may be either limited or shows may be sold out. Walk-in and phone-in sales begin October 24.

### What if I need to exchange my tickets for a different date?

There will be a \$2.00 handling charge for each ticket exchanged. Tickets must be presented when an exchange is made. No refunds can be made.

### Can I still purchase each show separately if I don't want a season subscription?

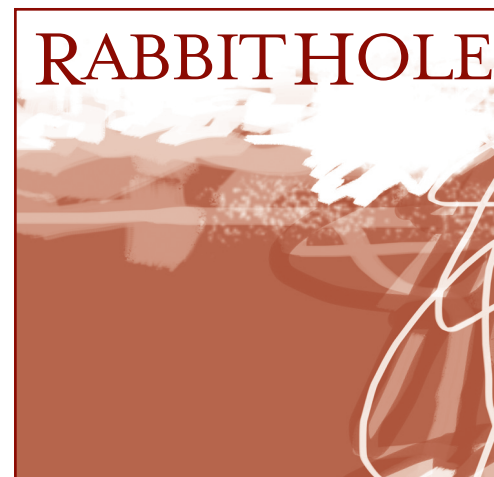
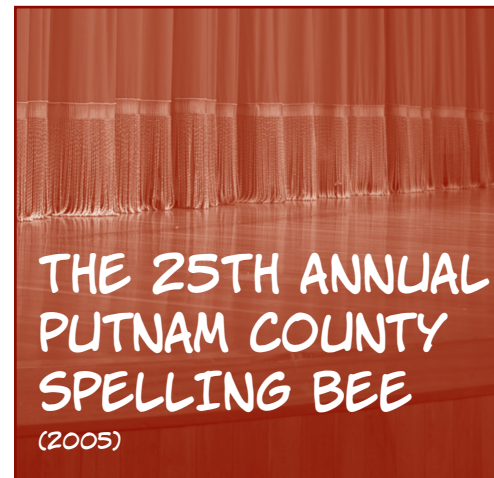
